

The Harris Family

The following information on the Harris name was written by Charles Guarino and appeared in August 7, 1975 issue of *The Dallas Morning News*.

Harris evolved from the personal name of Harry; etymologists also suggest another interesting facet and version of the name. In England the personal name of Harry was the accepted and correct pronunciation of Henry. Even the “Henry” kings were popularly known as Harry to their subjects which accounts in large measure for the popularity of the Harris surname.

Harris was first used to identify the “son of Henry” and became one of the most common of surnames in England as well as Wales. Robert Harris was a companion of William the Conqueror, named in the Domesday Book.

In studying the Harris name, it is interesting to take a look at the ancient name of Heryce, which undoubtedly also produced Harris families. The old Normal family of Herice descended from a son of the Count of Vendome. A “herison” was a hedgehog and this symbol appeared on the arms of the coats of the Earls of Malmesbury and Lord Herries. The Earls of Malmesbury were descendants of a William Harris, an inhabitant of Salisbury in 1469. Other notable Harris families were found in County Salop.

The name was brought in great numbers to the American Colonies. Thomas Harris came with Winthrop in 1630. He was one of the twelve who signed the Providence Plantation Compact with Roger Williams and became a proprietor of Providence, Rhode Island. His brother, William, came to Boston in 1636. He was sold into slavery by the Algerines, ransomed, and returned to England.

The Harris coat of arms is a white and blue banded shield with ermine fur and three gold circle rings thereon.

For more than forty years he made his home in Jamaica, and few of its residents were known better throughout the county. His boyhood years were passed in the place of his birth. In 1855, when twenty-five years of age, he moved to Jamaica as a telegraph operator for the Long Island Railroad Company. He remained in that capacity until 1861, when, in recognition of his ability, he was given charge of the station as agent. This was the most important station on the Long Island system, and he retained the position until he voluntarily retired in the summer of 1895. At the time of his arrival in Jamaica, the Long Island Railroad was a small affair, and he was connected with it during the entire period of its great development to every part of the island. He also became a stockholder in the railroad. In politics he was a Republican. He served on the board of village trustees and held other local offices of trust. In the Reformed Church, he served both as deacon and elder.

He married twice. He married Betsy Sarah Woods in Fitchburg, Worcester, Massachusetts, December 17, 1851. Betsy was born in Ashburnham, Worcester, Massachusetts April 17, 1823. Betsy was the daughter of Asa Woods and Rebecca Wallis. Betsy died January 8, 1865 in Jamaica, Queens, New York, at 41 years of age. Her body was interred in Jamaica, Queens, New York. He married Florence Hall in Jamaica, Queens, New York, June 18, 1867. Florence was born in Clinton, Oneida, New York May 8, 1842. Florence was the daughter of Dr. H. D. Hall. Florence died October 18, 1906 in Jamaica, Queens, New York, at 64 years of age.

43. Frederick Courtney⁸Harris (Herbert Woods⁷, Charles Hale⁶, William⁵, William⁴, Jonathan³, Jonathan², George¹) was born in Brooklyn, Kings, New York May 15, 1892. Frederick died November 15, 1967 in Dallas, Dallas, Texas, at 75 years of age.

As a result of being orphaned at age 13, his formal education did not extend past the seventh grade. He started a six year period of employment in 1907 with the Long Island Railroad, in the middle of which he spent one year as a ranch hand with a boyhood friend at Salina, Utah and Elko, Nevada in 1910-11. After two years in advertising in Binghamton, New York, he moved back to Jamaica, New York in 1917 to accept a position with the J. P. Morgan Company in their

export department, and then ran his own exporting and shipping company in New York City from 1919 to 1924. He entered the banking business with the Bank of Manhattan in 1924 as a branch manager of the Jamaica office, and, subsequently, was elevated to treasurer of the bank at the main office on Wall Street.

In 1932 the president of the bank purchased the Jamaica Trolley Company [later to become the Jamaica Bus Company] and installed him as vice president and general manager. The company grew to three lines serving much of Queens County. During this period he maintained a summer residence at Allenhurst, New Jersey, from 1931 to 1937. In 1935 he moved his family from Jamaica to Forest Hills, New York. When the bus company was sold in 1941, he accepted an appointment to the position of Chief Clerk of the Surrogate Court of Queens County, New York, in charge of the entire staff of the Court and all business matters relating thereto. His retirement was forced in 1955 due to a stroke, and upon recovery he and his wife move to Dallas, Texas to join son Roger who had taken up residence there the prior year.

He married Catherine Marion Pickhardt in New York, New York, New York, September 23, 1914. Catherine was born in New York, New York, New York January 11, 1894. Catherine was the daughter of John Frederick Henry Pickhardt and Cornelia Stillwell Smock. Catherine died April 24, 1981 in Plano, Collin, Texas, at 87 years of age. Catherine was employed at the Bell Telephone Company after graduating from Jamaica High School with honors. Frederick and Marion, admirably, willed their remains to the University of Texas Health Science Center in Dallas, Texas.

Frederick died June 1, 1944 in Fort Knox, Hardin, Kentucky, at 28 years of age. His body was interred June 6, 1944 in Flushing, Cemetery, Flushing, Queens, New York.

His formal education included graduation from the Jamaica Model School [elementary] in 1928, graduating from St. Paul's Preparatory School in Garden City, New York in 1933, and he studied at Columbia University in New York City for two years. After one year with the Federal Housing Administration in New York, he was employed with the Brevoort Savings Bank of Brooklyn in their real estate department for four years. During this time he married and took up residence in Kew Gardens, New York. In 1941 he changed his career path and joined the H. J. Heinz Company in the hotel and restaurant division. In 1943 he returned to the banking business with the Dollar Savings Bank, Bronx, New York.

Shortly afterwards he was called to military service as World War II was well underway. In October 1943 he entered the U. S. Army at Fort Knox, Kentucky, where he attained the rank of Corporal and was assigned to the permanent cadre at the Armored Replacement Training Center. He was killed at Fort Knox in a training exercise explosion. A posthumous Solider's Medal was pre-

sented his widow and young son by the War Department at ceremonies conducted at the 1st Army Headquarters, Governors Island, New York. The citation quoted, in part, the following account of his death:

“Harris saw flames, realized the danger to the men nearby, and without regard of his personal safety, rushed toward the nitrostarch explosives in an attempt to extinguish the fire.”

The explosion that followed resulted in his death and also killed seven other soldiers. His military burial took place on “D” Day.

He married Ethel Mae Donaldson in Harrison, Westchester, New York, January 21, 1940. Ethel was born in Philadelphia, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania September 25, 1916. Ethel was the daughter of Edwin Adam Donaldson and Ethel Winifred Shields. Ethel died February 9, 1999 at 82 years of age.
